



What's in the newspaper you're reading? And what's left out? Are you getting the coverage of local, international, political and economic stories you want or need? Our MediaRDI project is beginning to explore these questions. We've started by analyzing the New York Times over the last 25 years. These graphs compare foreign and domestic coverage. We are currently developing technologies that will allow us to offer this kind of analysis as a type of "nutritional information label" for various media sources.
